Emerging Leaders for Children's 2024 Beneficiary Medically Complex Care Program

Launched in 2017, The Medically Complex Care Program at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta exists to improve the quality of life for some of our most complex patients by providing patient and family centered care that is comprehensive, collaborative and coordinated. There are approximately 100,000 medically complex children in Georgia.

Children in our Medically Complex Program have multiple chronic conditions, including all of the following:

- Severe neurological injury
- Technology dependence
- More than 3 specialists
- A history of hospitalizations

The Medically Complex Care Program consists of a multidisciplinary team of physicians, advanced practice providers, nurses, social workers, case managers, respiratory therapists and nutritionists. When a child has complex care needs, at Children's they have one team that manages their continuum of care—both inside and outside the hospital.

Our goals within the Medically Complex Care Program include:

- Optimizing the health of our medically complex patients
- Improving the overall patient and family experience
- Increasing collaboration of care

Scrubs Party Overview

In 2014, the inaugural Scrubs Party was held by Emerging Leaders for Children's (ELC), raising \$154,000 for ECMO Technology. Since then, Scrubs has become one of the most popular spring events in Atlanta! From Range Rover raffles to unique silent auctions, ELC has raised more than **\$5 Million** for Children's programs.

-2020-

\$564,000 raised for Children's Food Allergy Program despite last minute shift to virtual event due to COVID-19 lockdown

-2021-

Raised more than \$800,000 for Children's Behavioral and Mental Health Initiative and hosted "An Evening at Home with ELC" which included a virtual program and at-home gatherings across Atlanta.

-2022-

More than 500 guests gathered at The Stave Room in support of Children's Behavioral and Mental Health Initiative. For the first time ever, the event grossed more than \$1 million.

-2023-

With a return to The Stave Room, over \$800,000 was raised to support the Sickle Cell Disease Program at the Aflac Cancer & Blood Disorders Center of Children's Healthcare of Atlanta.
