Emerging Leaders for Children's 2023 Beneficiary Sickle Cell Disease Program

Sickle Cell Disease, SCD, is an inherited blood disorder that affects a person's red blood cells. Red blood cells contain hemoglobin, which carries oxygen from the lungs to all parts of the body. People without SCD have red blood cells that are round, smooth, and flexible, flowing easily through blood vessels while people with SCD have red blood cells that are abnormally shaped which makes it harder for them to flow smoothly through the blood vessels and may block blood flow to parts of the body causing pain, infection, acute chest syndrome (severe pneumonia), stroke, and major damage to organs.

According to the Center for Disease Control, people with SCD have less access to comprehensive care than people with other genetic disorders such as hemophilia and cystic fibrosis. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, there are fewer specialty clinics available for the care of SCD, which are less likely to be networked and ultimately not used as widely as clinics specializing in the care of other genetic disorders.

Georgia is home to one of the nation's largest populations of individuals with Sickle Cell Disease, with more than 7,000 individuals living with the disease across the state. Sickle Cell Disease occurs in about 1 out of 880 babies born in Georgia.

In Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, parents have an ally. Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is home to the largest pediatric Sickle Cell Disease Program in the country and has been recognized as a national leader in treating patients with Sickle Cell Disease with blood and marrow transplant (BMT), the only known cure for kids with this disease.

96% of BMT patients survived transplant.

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve the health of children with Sickle Cell Disease and hematologic disorders, our team actively participates in investigator-initiated research studies and multi-institutional clinical trials on a regional and national basis.
